

日本救急医学会／アジア救急医学会 合同シンポジウム

本シンポジウムはアジア各国と日本がそれぞれの救急医療についての理解を深め、今後の協力を探るために企画された。事前にアジア救急医学会（ASEM）に正式加盟している10カ国の代表者に、各国の救急医療の実情に関するアンケートを送付しており、その内容のまとめを最初に司会者（Dr.Lim）が紹介する。
